## DIGGING DEEPER

1. It's no surprise that it can be challenging to reach out to or accept those who are different or have a belief system contrary to our own. Read 1 Timothy 1:12-16. How does the Apostle Paul's understanding of his past and what God did for him impact his viewpoint of others?
